As the managing partner of a law firm of over 20 attorneys and staff, my responsibilities have included the planning and development of firm databases to provide progress tracking, task management, document preparation and invoicing for several lines of work handled by the firm. I have undertaken much of this effort myself in years past, having over ten years of experience with database creation and programming.

About six years ago, the increasing time devoted to this work, as well as the growing complexity of our very large databases, required that I go to outside support for assistance.

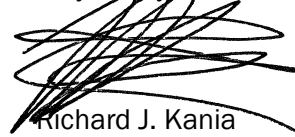
Our firm worked with several local IT vendors, but our experience with them was disappointing. It was evident to me that my knowledge and experience with database design and implementation exceeded these experts.

Erin's contribution to our firm has been essential. We literally could not perform at our current level of productivity and accuracy without her work. Her depth of knowledge, her insight, and her creativity (an essential aspect of superior database design) are rare, and will benefit any enterprise that is fortunate enough to work with her.
